HOW TO MAKE AN MTG KOHA STONE....

WHAT IS A KOHA?

Put simply, koha is a Māori term for a gift. It's a way in which you can express gratitude in the form of a physical gift, like money, food, or something priceless, like some great advice.

When a school visits us at MTG sometimes they bring a koha. Sometimes it's a special waiata or a beautifully decorated stone.



MATERIALS YOU WILL NEED

- Rock
- Sandpaper (optional)
- Primer (White paint is fine too)
- Pencil
- Paints of your choice
- Sharpie or felt tip pen
- Polyurethane (optional)



WHAT YOU WILL NEED TO MAKE YOUR OWN KOHA ROCK


Instructions

- Clean (wash and dry) the rock.
- 2. Rough up the surface with sandpaper if needed for better paint adhesion. (this step is optional)
- 3. Apply primer/white paint (optional) and allow to dry thoroughly.
- Draw your design with pencil.
- 5. Paint with coloured paints.
- 6. Add details and outlines with Sharpie marker.
- 7. Apply two coats of exterior polyurethane for protection. (this is optional too and best if an adult does this step)
